 - B. Leadership ability as expressed through co-curricular activities and community involvement.
 - C. Essay
 - D. Recommendations
4. Applications materials must be postmarked no later than May 4th.
5. Applications must be typed or in pen. No penciled applications will be accepted.

2. Include two letters of recommendation, one of which must be written by a teacher, counselor or principal.

3. Attach essay as directed on the application form.
